1ST AIBR INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF ANTHROPOLOGY.

CALL FOR PANEL PROPOSALS, PAPERS, POSTERS, AND FILMS

The Network of Iberoamerican Anthropologists (AIBR) organizes the *1st AIBR International Conference of Anthropology* with the theme "The Human Being, Cultures, Origins and Destiny", which will take place between the 7th and 10th of July 2015 in the city of Madrid, Spain.

With an open program featuring more than 200 thematic sessions, the *1st AIBR International Conference of Anthropology* is a general call for specialists in our discipline, as well as for those who are interested in knowing more about Human Beings, both biologically as socially and culturally.

Structure and norms for panels, papers, posters, and films:

1. Deadline for the proposal of panels, papers, and posters: 31st of October 2014.
2. Members per panel: A minimum of 3 panelists and a maximum of 6. The first panelist will serve as coordinator and moderator of the panel, being allowed to present a paper. Exceptionally, the conference's organization will unify two panels with similar topics, and will complete panels with individual papers.
3. Individual papers will be grouped in new panels, or included in panels that have already been proposed, when the latter share similar topics and has available spots.
4. Each presenter will be given a maximum time of 15 minutes. Although a lecture can bear more than one signature, each lecture shall be performed by one person only. The maximum duration of each panel will be two hours.
5. Apart from the quality and relevance criteria, the organization will grant priority to panels encompassing the following factors:
 - a) Diversity: Those in which panelists come from different countries and universities.
 - b) Presentation: Those in which panelists give non-read lectures, pursuing a higher engagement with the audience.
6. Films: Films and documentaries may be sent through the individual paper form (left menu). The organization reserves the right to preview the material before acceptance.
7. Poster proposals: these shall be sent through the individual paper form.
8. By January 1st, 2015, panelists will be informed whether their panel has been accepted. Panelists will be granted two months (by February 28th 2015) to fulfill the payment of the conference's fees. After that date the panels where the members have not paid the fees will be automatically eliminated
9. Participants are restricted to one paper. Exceptionally, participants may be part of a maximum of two different panels.
10. Language: We recommend the use of only one language in all the papers belonging to the same panel in order to encourage the public's participation, but panel discussions will be allowed to be conducted in several languages. Accepted languages are Spanish, English, Portuguese, and French.
11. Topics: The conference is open to all of the discipline's fields: Applied Anthropology, Sociocultural Anthropology, Linguistics, Biological Anthropology and Archaeology.

Note: Our norms are subject to modifications by the conference's organizing committee, as well as by AIBR's Board of Directors.
